# PARKING AT GAMES

Parking can be an issue at Gallagher Hockey Stadium (GHC). There are alternatives around Lake Domain and even at the train station, both within a 5 minute walk. Exiting GHC (Mary St ONLY) can be a struggle at the best of times. PLEASE <u>don't</u> sit at the Mary St intersection and try to <u>turn right</u>, go left across the railroad and look to use a side street to change direction.

## EQUIPMENT

Children will need to have their own hockey stick, shin guards, and mouth guard for practices and games, otherwise, they will not be able to play. These are available as a package deal from Go Hockey at the Gallagher Hockey Centre from as little as \$39.90. The starter pack contains a stick, shinpads, a ball, and a mouthguard.
