Learning in Room 10

Literacy:

Writing will be a major focus in Room 10 this year. During the first term we will be working on descriptive writing and recount writing. This will allow your child to write about their own personal experiences and describe a range of objects. Your child will work on individual writing goals that will be identified during the first few weeks. We will also look at handwriting and spelling. In class we will be reading a variety of instructional readers, journals and chapter books. Each week your child will have a book to bring home and read with you. I will also have TeachYourMonsterToRead which is an app for reading.

Maths:

Within our class this term, we will be focusing on statistics and number knowledge.

Topic:

This term, Room 10 will cover the topics of Olympics and culture. We will be identifying the origins and history of the Olympics and then relating this to the modern day. As part of our culture topic we will be using our class's own variety of cultures to create a culture wall, this will also lead into the cultural celebration in week 8.

P.E. and Swimming:

Your child will be learning a range of cooperation games that will help build their communication skills and ability to get along with others, as well as playing by the rules and thinking first. Our swimming days are Tuesday and Thursday. Please ensure that your child has their togs and towel in a named bag on these days and your child wears named clothing. If your child is unable to swim, please let me know, as swimming is an important part of our P.E. curriculum.

Library:
