The Knighton Way, we will talk about what makes a 'Cool Knighton Kid' who gets along at Knighton School.

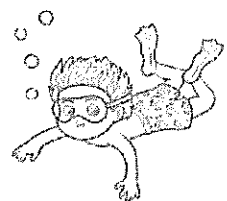
Zones of Regulation - like a car, sometimes we need a rest, we can be ready to go, we need to slow down, or stop because there is danger!

Cultural Celebration, we will learn about the cultures represented in Room 14 and take part in the celebration parade.

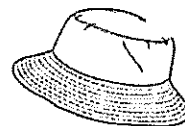
In the Beginning, we explore the Atua Māori in this lovely book by Peter Gossage. What might they look like? Can we create our own versions?
