What are head lice?

Nits - Kutis - Headlouse Kutu bugs - Cooties



Anyone can get head lice – it doesn't matter how clean or dirty a person's hair is. Head lice spread by crawling from one person's hair to another's – usually between people who are in close contact, such as family or school classmates.

Remember:

- Check your children's hair every week for head lice.
 - If you find lice or eggs you need to treat them.

• Repeat the treatment 7 days later. We have information about a wet combing treatment method and free nit combs available at the school office. Te Hihiri students - Week 8 21st, 22nd & 23rd June

- ★ Please pack a change of clothes with your child everyday.




Save the date: Book Fair 28th June - 1st July In the school Library
