Measles Update

With a large number of measles cases, particularly in South Auckland, Waikato Public Health is recommending that we update our schools immunisation register. While we have no known cases of Measles at Knighton we must be prepared in case of an outbreak.

We will be sending letters home with all children for whom we have not received verification that they have been fully immunised. The school does not require your child to be immunised but we do need to know whether they are immunised or not.

If in the future we have a confirmed case of measles in our school, all students who are not immunised AND students for whom we have no record of being immunised will be excluded from school as per the Health (Infectious and Notifiable Diseases) Regulations 1966 (Regulation 14).
