Te Wiki o te Reo Māori

Māori Language Day is September 14 and commemorates the presentation of the 1972 Māori language petition to parliament.

Mahuru Māori is an initiative begun in 2017 to promote the use of te reo Māori throughout the month of September.

Māori language week is an opportunity for concentrated celebration, promotion and encouragement. We can choose to use te reo – every time we do, even just a 'Kia ora!' contributes to revitalisation.

Measles Update

Reminder - With a large number of measles cases, particularly in South Auckland, Waikato Public Health is recommending that we update our schools immunisation register. While we have no known cases of Measles at Knighton we must be prepared in case of an outbreak.

Last week we sent letters home with all children for whom we have not received verification that they have been fully immunised. The school does not require your child to be immunised but we do need to know whether they are immunised or not. If you have not already done so, please send immunisation verification to the school office as soon as possible.

If, in the future, we have a confirmed case of measles in our school, all students who are not immunised AND students for whom we have no record of being immunised will be excluded from school as per the Health (Infectious and Notifiable Diseases) Regulations 1966 (Regulation 14).

Women's Suffrage - Pay Equity

Women's Suffrage Day is next Thursday 19 September. Since 2017 NZEI have been working through the process of negotiating with the Ministry of Education for pay equity for our school support staff — Learning Assistants, Office Staff and Librarians.

These staff are very underpaid for the work they do, in fact, when the minimum wage went up earlier this year the bottom four tiers of the pay rates had to be immediately adjusted so they didn't sink below the minimum wage rate. You have been very generous supporting our teachers and Principal through their contract negotiations, now we ask for a show of support for support staff by wearing black and white next Thursday 19 September.

Notice for 2020 Out of Zone Enrolments
