Cultural Celebration, we will learn about the cultures represented in Room 14 and take part in the celebration parade.

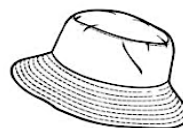
Te Tiriti o Waitangi, what is an agreement? We look at the importance of honouring agreements and what that might look like for five year olds.
