STEELE PARK JUNIOR COMPETITION

TERM 4- 2019 6 week competition

Venue: Cook Street, Hamilton East, Hamilton

Mondays: October 21, November 4,11,18, 25 December 2 2019 = 6 Weeks

Playing Rounds: 3.45, 4.15, 4.45, 5.15, 5.45, 6.15, 6.45. These are subject to change.

Grades Available: Year 3&4 Mixed, Year 5&6 Boys, Year 5&6 Mixed, Year 7&8 Mixed.

Game duration: Games will be 12 minutes each way with a 2 minute half time. There will be 4 minutes in between rounds.

All teams must have an adult register at least 10 minutes before your game, Team 1 on the draw takes the scorecard and the winning team is responsible for returning the card after both teams have agreed and signed the card. If scorecards are not returned, no points are issued to either team and we will not take responsibility for this.

Teams are expected to be available for all games throughout the competition, it is very difficult for us to accommodate special requests when dealing with such a large competition and number of teams. If there are any games your school/team cannot play, please notify the opposition team as well as Waikato Touch, once the draw is out. The opposition team will be given the 3 point win.

Touch boots or sneakers are compulsory for all players. No shoes, no play! No long skins allowed. Each team may be required to ref half a game so please be prepared for this, and please do your best to referee as fair as possible.

Cancellations: Cancellations of modules due to bad weather will be put on the website by 2pm at the latest. However we are very unlikely to cancel any modules unless Hamilton City Council close the grounds, so all games will go ahead, Rain or Shine.

Previously mixed grades required a minimum of 3 girls, we will now allow a minimum of 2 on the field to allow more mixed teams to be involved.

We always endeavor to have the draws up on the website at least 3 days prior to your first game.
