

ROAD PATROL CALLS

CALLS FOR GOING ON PATROL:

LEAD: "SIGNS OUT" – (Place signs out quickly – raise left arm)

LEAD: "CHECK" – (Both team members look both ways)

LEAD: "CHECK" – (Both team members look both ways)
Other team member: "CLEAR" – (Calls 'clear' once road is clear or car stopp

Other team member: "CLEAR" – (Calls 'clear' once road is clear or car stopped/slowed down)

"ON PATROL" (leaves arm raised and waits for other team member to cross)

LEAD "SIGNS IN" (Doesn't need to wait for team member to set up – Lead

patroller walks sign backwards keeping eye on traffic)

(STAGGERED) CALLS FOR WHEN CROSSING PEOPLE:

LEAD: "SIGN OUT" (place sign out – left arm raised)

Other team member: "SIGN OUT" (place sign out – left arm raised)

LEAD: "CHECK" (Both team members check both directions)

Other team member: "CLEAR" (Calls 'clear' once road is clear or car stopped/slowed down)

LEAD "CROSS NOW" (Left arms are lowered whilst persons cross,)

Left arm raised again after the last person has walked past them.

LEAD "SIGNS IN" (both patrollers walk sign backwards keeping eye on traffic)

CALLS FOR GOING OFF PATROL:

LEAD: "SIGNS OUT" – (Both members place signs out promptly – raise left arm)

LEAD: "CHECK" – (Both team members look both ways)

Other team member: "CLEAR" – (Calls 'clear' once road is clear or car stopped /slowing down)

LEAD "OFF PATROL" (leaves arm raised; waits for other team member to

disconnect sign and return safely)

LEAD "SIGNS IN" (Patrollers lift leads sign together and stretcher carry)
