# **Team Coaches and Managers**

Basketball New Zealand has now introduced an annual Basketball development Levy of \$5 for under 14 year olds. All players need parents/whānau to register and make their \$5 levi payment for their child, online at Basketball NZ. Payment for the Levy must be made before they can play for our Knighton team. If your child has played in Term 1 you do not need to pay again.
